

Marks of a Disciple

Introduction.

- A. Christians are commanded to disciple the nations (Mt. 28:18-20).
- B. Definition: a disciple is one who follows the master with the intention of becoming like him.
- C. Becoming Christ's disciple requires singularity of purpose (Ps. 16:2; Ph. 3:13-14; Ro. 8:29).
- D. Jesus said of at least five things that doing them is the mark of a disciple.

I. I must deny myself and take up my cross daily (Lk. 9:23).

II. I must give up to Christ everything I have (Lk. 14: 26-33).

III. I must hold to Christ's teaching (Jn. 8: 31).

IV. I must love other Christians (Jn. 13:35).

V. I must bear much fruit (Jn. 15: 8).
